## FIM ENDURANCE CUP (1960-74)

Results up to 1969 are presumed standings – some race results are missing, and FIM confirmation not available for all the years. For 1972, FIM announced a cup winner, and then annulled the results because of insufficient rounds; in 1973 & 1974, no results were announced. The tables for 1972-74 are therefore unofficial.

Points as for Grand Prix. No. of wins does not necessarily equal no. of rounds, since 2-3 riders shared a bike.
